Frequently asked questions

What is TeamSTEM?

TeamSTEM is a longitudinal coaching program (of 16 weeks in length), designed to support and enhance the competence and confidence of middle years STEM teachers. The program will support teachers in the development and delivery of STEM units. These can be approached from a specific discipline (Science, Mathematics, Technology etc.) or from an interdisciplinary perspective depending on the role and context of the individual participants.

What will I be doing?

You will be working alongside both expert educators and peers to develop highly engaging contemporary units that you can implement in your school. The main aim of this program is to support you in your role in 2019, not to add to your already busy work schedule.

What is the time commitment?

Teachers will participate in a full day workshop at Earth Ed on the 28 February 2019, or 31 July 2019. Following on from this will be a series of blended support involving the WebEx Teams platform, in school coaching along with phone and email support. Other than the initial day there is flexibility around days and times however you should allow roughly an hour a week for 15 weeks after your face to face workshop.

How will I be supported?

TeamSTEM will be supported through:

- Access to online and offline resources
- Face to face workshops
- WebEx seminars and catch ups both one on one and as a group
- In school coaching
- Phone and email support.
